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16 On the 28th day of October, 2009, this matter came on before the State of Nevada, Local
17 Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board"), for consideration and decision
18 pursuant to the provisions of NRS and NAC chapters 288, NRS chapter 233B, and was properly
19 noticed pursuant to Nevada's open meeting laws.

20 The Board, having duly considered the pleadings on file, fully considered the law and
21 being fully advised in the premises makes its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order as
22 follows:

23 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 24 1. The Complaint in this matter was filed on January 29, 2008 by Complainant Nye County
25 Law Enforcement Association.
26 2. Respondent County of Nye and Nye County Sheriffs Office did not file an Answer to the
27 Complaint.
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- 1 3. On July 16, 2008 the Board ordered the parties to file pre-hearing statements within 20
2 days of the date said order.
- 3 4. The parties requested additional time to file pre-hearing statements. Subsequently the
4 Board, in an order dated September 10, 2008, ordered that the parties submit pre-hearing
5 statements to the Board no later than November 1, 2008.
- 6 5. The Board has not received from any party the pre-hearing statements that were ordered
7 to be filed by November 1, 2008.
- 8 6. More than one year has passed since the parties requested additional time to file pre-
9 hearing statements, and during that time Complainant has failed to prosecute its
10 Complaint.
- 11 7. If any of the foregoing findings is more appropriately construed a finding of fact, it may
12 be so construed.

13 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 14 1. Pursuant to NAC 288.375(3), the Board may dismiss a Complaint if the Complainant
15 fails to prosecute its complaint within a reasonable time.
- 16 2. By failing to file pre-hearing statements by the November 2008 deadline imposed by the
17 Board and by failure to otherwise prosecute the Complaint for more than one year,
18 Complainant has failed to prosecute its Complaint within a reasonable time under NAC
19 288.375(3).
- 20 3. Dismissal of the Complaint due to failure to prosecute is appropriate.

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4. If any of the foregoing conclusions is more appropriately construed a finding of fact, it may be so construed.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this matter be Dismissed.


