16 On the 28th day of October, 2009, this matter came on before the State of Nevada, Local  
17 Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board"), for consideration and decision  
18 pursuant to the provisions of NRS and NAC chapters 288, NRS chapter 233B, and was properly  
19 noticed pursuant to Nevada's open meeting laws.

20 The Board, having duly considered the pleadings filed herein, and having fully  
21 considered the law and being fully advised in the premises makes its Findings of Fact,  
22 Conclusions of Law and Order as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

23 1. Complainants North Las Vegas Peace Officers Association and Officer Gianni  
24 Cavaricci filed a Complaint in this action September 3, 2009.

25 2. On October 7, 2009 Complainants filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal Without  
26 Prejudice with the Board.

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1 3. No Answer or other responsive pleading had been filed by Respondents City of  
2 North Las Vegas and North Las Vegas Police Department at the time that Complainants' Notice  
3 of Voluntary Dismissal was filed.

4 4. If any of the foregoing findings is more appropriately construed a conclusion of  
5 law, it may be so construed.

6 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

7 1. Complainants' Notice of Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice is proper.

8 2. If any of the foregoing conclusions is more appropriately construed a finding of  
9 fact, it may be so construed.

10 **ORDER**

11 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Complainants' Notice of Voluntary Dismissal Without  
12 Prejudice is accepted by the Board;

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this action is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
