Dixon, Esq. 15 On the 15th day of February, 2011, this matter came on before the State of Nevada, Local 16 Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board"), for consideration and decision 17 pursuant to the provisions of NRS and NAC chapters 288, NRS chapter 233B, and was properly 18 noticed pursuant to Nevada's open meeting laws. 19 The Board has previously dismissed Respondent City of Mesquite from this matter. On January 18, 2010 Complainant Tracy Fails and the remaining respondent Mesquite Police 20 21 Officers Association filed a Stipulation to Dismiss and requested that this Board dismiss the 22 complaint with prejudice. 23 The Board, having duly considered the pleadings filed herein, and having fully 24 considered the law and being fully advised in the premises makes its Findings of Fact, 25 Conclusions of Law and Order as follows: 26 FINDINGS OF FACT

- The Stipulation for Dismissal of a Party complies with the provisions of NAC 288.375(1), and the Board accepts the same.
- The Motion for Summary Judgment filed by Mesquite Police Officers Association on December 30, 2010 is rendered moot by the Stipulation for Dismissal.
- If any of the foregoing conclusions is more appropriately construed a finding of fact, it
  may be so construed.

## ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this action is dismissed with prejudice, each party to bear its own fees and costs.
