Vaskov, Esq. for City of North Las Vegas et al. 25 On the 13th day of June, 2011, this matter came on before the State of Nevada, Local 26 Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board"), for consideration and decision 27 111 28

 pursuant to the provisions of NRS and NAC chapters 288, NRS chapter 233B, and was properly noticed pursuant to Nevada's open meeting laws.

At issue were the City's motion to consolidate Case No. A1-046014 and Case No. A1-046018, the Association's motion to dismiss or in the alternative motion for summary judgment, and the City's countermotion to disqualify. Each of these motions are addressed separately below.

Motion to Consolidate

The Board finds that consolidation of Case No. A1-046014 and Case No. A1-046018 is appropriate pursuant to NAC 288.275. The issues are substantially related and the rights of parties will not be prejudiced by a consolidation. Accordingly, Case No. A1-046014 and Case No. A1-046018 are hereby consolidated under the caption used above in this order.

Motion to Dismiss or in the Alternative Motion for Summary Judgment

The North Las Vegas Police Officers Association asks that the Board dismiss the City's request to withdraw recognition of the Association. The bases for this motion are that 1) the request does not comply with the formal pleading requirements, and 2) that the City's claim is frivolous and unfounded.

The City opposed the motion and acknowledged that its application to withdraw recognition does not comply with certain technical requirements under NAC 288.231, but that dismissal for these shortcomings is not warranted. The Board agrees with the City. NAC 288.235(2) states that "[p]leadings, motions and other papers will be liberally construed, and any defects which do not affect substantial rights of any party may be disregarded by the Board." Therefore, the Board does not find a basis for dismissing the City's application due to the defects in the pleading pointed out by the Association.

The Board disagrees with the Association's argument that the Application should be dismissed at this time. Although neither NRCP 12 nor NRCP 56 apply to Board proceedings, there still remain genuine issues of material fact that cannot be decided via the Association's motion. Therefore the Board denies the Association's motion to dismiss or in the alternative motion for summary judgment.

Countermotion to Disqualify

The City has also filed a countermotion to disqualify Richard McCann from representing the Association in this proceeding, arguing that the representation does not meet the requirements under NAC 288.278 for representation in contested cases. The Board agrees with the City.

Under NAC 288.278(1), representation in a contested case before the Board may either be in proper person or by an attorney licensed to practice law in Nevada. There is no dispute that Mr. McCann is not a Nevada-licensed attorney. In order for an employee organization to represent itself in proper person, it must be represented by an individual who is a member of the organization. NAC 288.278(4). The Association acknowledges that it is the exclusive bargaining agent for the North Las Vegas Police Sergeants and Lieutenants. Under NRS 288.140(3), membership in this organization must be "composed exclusively of law enforcement officers." Mr. McCann has not asserted that he is a law enforcement officer, thus he may not be considered as a member of North Las Vegas Police Supervisors Association. Therefore his representation in this matter cannot be considered to be in proper person representation by the Association.

Although Mr. McCann has previously appeared before this Board, and is well-qualified to appear before the Board, in this case the criteria of NAC 288.278 are not met. The City's motion to disqualify Mr. McCann is granted.
