ORDER ON RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO STAY AND FULL OR PARTIAL DEFERRAL

EN BANC

**ITEM NO. 867** 

On June 24, 2020, this matter came before the State of Nevada, Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board") for consideration and decision pursuant to the provisions of the Employee-Management Relations Act, NAC Chapter 288, and NRS Chapter 233B. At issue was Respondent's Motion for Stay and Full or Partial Deferral.

Respondent and the employee organization have a negotiated grievance and arbitration procedure, and Complainant Micone has filed a grievance in connection therewith. Respondent requests the Board stay this matter pending the decision or resolution of the contractual grievance. Complainants acknowledged that they must exhaust their administrative remedies, pursue the underlying grievance, and that this Board may defer its decision in this matter until after the underlying grievance is resolved.

The Board has repeatedly emphasized that the preferred method for resolving disputes is through the bargained-for processes, and the Board applies NAC 288.375 liberally to effectuate that purpose. Moreover, the Board generally may defer to arbitration proceedings in consideration with its exclusive jurisdiction and, in such cases, it is the practice of the Board to stay matters during the arbitration process. IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the matter be STAYED pending exhaustion of contractual remedies consistent with the above.
