12	On December 29, 2022, this matter came before the State of Nevada, Government Employee-				
13	Management Relations Board (Board) for consideration and decision pursuant to the provisions of the				
14	Employee-Management Relations Act (NRS Chapter 288, EMRA) and NAC 288. At issue was				
15	certification of the results of the recently held election.				
16	History				
17	On October 4, 2022, Complainant filed a Request for Election. After a review of the record,				
18	including the staff audit of the request, the Board deliberated on October 13, 2022, and decided to grant				
19	the request for an election and recommend an election be held pursuant to NRS 288.525(2)(a)-(c).				
20	Thereupon, on November 3, 2022, the Board ordered the holding of a representation election, including				
21	the adoption of the election plan as proposed by the Commissioner.				
22	The election closed on December 12, 2022, and a counting of the ballots was completed on				
23	December 13, 2022. A copy of the Tally of Ballots is attached hereto. Section 5.01 of the Election Plan				
24	allowed any party to file objections as to the conduct of the election by December 23, 2022. None were				
25	filed.				
26	NRS 288.530(4) states the standard for determining the outcome of an election, which reads as				
27	follows:

If a labor organization receives a majority of the votes cast at the initial election or at any runoff election, the Board shall designate the labor organization as the exclusive representative of the bargaining unit. Thus, according to the standard used for determining the outcome of the election, it is determined that the Fraternal Order of Police Nevada C.O. Lodge 21 received a majority of the votes cast and thus				
6	is designated as the exclusive representative of the bargaining unit.				
7	ORDER				
8	Based on the foregoing, it is hereby DECLARED and ORDERED that the Fraternal Order of				
9	Police Nevada C.O. Lodge 21 is hereby designated as the exclusive representative of State of Nevada				
10	Bargaining Unit I (i.e., Category III Peace Officers) effective immediately and that all prior designations				
11	of exclusive representatives for this bargaining unit are hereby null and void.
