LABOR ARBITRATION FEES AND POLICIES

FEES: The per diem rate for labor arbitrations is \$1800 for each day of eight hours or any part thereof spent at hearing or in study and preparation of the award.

TRAVEL EXPENSES: No travel per diem fee or travel expenses will be charged for virtual hearings. For in-person hearings in MA, RI, and parts of NH, no travel per diem fee will be charged for in-person hearings. For single-day hearings within 100 miles of Salem, MA, I will charge for mileage only and not seek reimbursement for travel expenses, unless it is necessary for me to obtain hotel accommodations due to weather. For hearings more than 100 miles outside of Salem, MA, I require reimbursement for reasonable travel expenses and a per diem travel fee. I reserve the right to ask the parties to agree to a virtual hearing to avoid potential weather or public health concerns, particularly between November 15 and March 1. If the parties cannot agree, I may withdraw and waive any cancellation fee if my request for a virtual hearing arises within the cancellation period.

CANCELLATION FEE: For any hearing canceled within thirty days of the first day of the scheduled hearing, I charge a cancellation fee of my per diem rate for each day within thirty days of the first day. If the parties reschedule the hearing, I may waive the cancellation fee.
