2024 FEE SCHEDULE (PD increases one-hundred dollars each January 1)

Arbitration Per Diem: \$2,600. Mediation/Interest Per Diem: \$3,100. PD charged for any portion of a day up to seven hours; pro rata after seven hours and for conference, study, and writing. If a matter is canceled or postponed with notice of 30 or fewer calendar days, PD charged for each day set unless parties set a like matter in its place. Half PD charged for each one-way travel over two hours. No charge for travel under two hours. Reasonable expenses charged.
