**Charles Ebarb v. Clark County & Clark County Water Reclamation District**

The Board deliberated on the motion to dismiss, and upon motion, the Board ordered: (1) a hearing to occur pursuant to the Board's prior orders; (2) a hearing to occur on whether there had been unequivocal notice and the applicability of equitable tolling in conjunction with Respondents' Motion to Dismiss filed in December 2019; (3) that the parties be prepared for any questions the Board may have as related to Respondents' Motion to Dismiss filed in December 2019; and (4) that the Commissioner is to consult with the parties to determine whether an additional prehearing conference should be held and, if either party so requests, the Commissioner shall then hold said conference and issue a notice of hearing consistent therewith.


**5. Additional Period of Public Comment**
