Water Employees Association of Nevada v. Las Vegas Valley Water District

The Panel deliberated on Complainant's Motion to Amend Pre-Hearing Statement, and upon motion, granted the motion. This was done with the caveat that it is acceptable to amend a prehearing statement for additional evidence and witnesses for claims already made but it is not the proper place to add new claims, which would need to be done by seeking to amend the complaint.


4. Additional Period of Public Comment
