**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO SOLICIT STAKEHOLDER COMMENTS
PER EXECUTIVE ORDER 2026-003 PROVIDING FOR THE REVIEW OF REGULATIONS
OF THE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE-MANAGEMENT RELATIONS BOARD
AND HEARING AGENDA**

The Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("EMRB") hereby provides notice of a public hearing concerning Governor Lombardo's Executive Order 2026-003. The purpose of the hearing is to solicit comments and recommendations from interested people and stakeholders regarding the EMRB's existing regulations contained in NAC Chapter 288, and whether those regulations may be appropriate for streamlining, clarification, revision, or removal.

Nevada Administrative Code Chapter 288, titled "Relations Between Governments and Public Employees," contains the official administrative regulations that govern public-sector labor relations, collective bargaining, and union recognition for government workers in the State of Nevada.

The public hearing has been set for Friday, October 9, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. in the Carl Dodge Conference Room, located at Suite 490 of the Nevada State Business Center, 3300 W. Sahara Avenue, Las Vegas, NV 89102.

The hearing will also be conducted virtually by Microsoft Teams. 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Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the EMRB may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views, or arguments, in written form, to the Government Employee-Management Relations Board. The EMRB welcomes public comment. Public comment must be limited to matters relevant to or within the authority of the Government Employee-Management Relations Board. No subject may be acted upon unless that subject is on the agenda and scheduled for possible action.

If you wish to be heard, please introduce yourself at the appropriate time and the Commissioner will recognize you. For those attending virtually or by telephone, please raise your hand to indicate that you wish to speak and take yourself off mute. When recognized, clearly state and spell your first and last name for the record before providing your comments. Each speaker will be limited to three (3) minutes, which can be adjusted at the discretion of the Commissioner, and the amount of discussion on any single subject may also be limited at the discretion of the Commissioner, and public comment based upon viewpoint will not be restricted.

2. Solicitation of Comments and Suggestions on Proposed Regulatory Amendments to Ensure They Are Streamlined, Clarified, Reduced, or Otherwise Improved

Section 1 of Executive Order 2026-003 requires every executive branch department and agency to repeal, streamline, clarify, reduce, or otherwise improve its regulations, with the goal of minimizing barriers to economic efficiency.
