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21	Complainant, LAS VEGAS POLICE PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATION, by and through its			
22	attorney of record, David Roger, Esq; Respondent, the City of Las Vegas (hereinafter "City" or			
23	"CLV"), by and through its attorney of record, Nechole Garcia, Esq. hereby submit their Joint			
24	Status Report pursuant to the Commissioner's email dated July 19, 2023 in the above referenced			
25	matter.			
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This case was stayed by the Board on November 5, 2021. The Association has filed two complaints for declaratory relief in District Court.

In case no. A-21-835584-C, the Court is asked to decide whether the collective bargaining agreement requires the City to pay longevity benefits to officers.

A related case has been filed in case no. A-21-845029-C, which asks the court to determine whether the collective bargaining agreement allows the City to refuse to arbitrate longevity benefit claims when the City believes the grievances are untimely. The case was consolidated with A-21-835584-C.

The parties completed discovery and obtained a new trial date. The City filed a motion for summary judgment which was set for hearing on July 31, 2024. The trial date was set for November 12, 2024.

Additionally, the original arbitration hearing, which included the first grievants, was vacated pending negotiations. The parties have been unable to resolve the matter and a new date has not been set.

Since the last report, the pending hearing on the City's Motion for Summary Judgment, which was scheduled for July 31, 2024, occurred. Prior to hearing the motion, Judge Newberry recused herself from the case. Judge Honorable Ronald J. Israel was assigned the case on August 16, 2024.

On August 21, 2024, Judge Israel issued an Order indicating that he would be issuing a decision on the City's Motion for Summary Judgment without a hearing. Judge Israel has yet to issue a decision on the City's Motion for Summary Judgment.

On October 15, 2024, the parties submitted a Stipulation and Order to Continue Trial to the Court, based, in part, on the fact that the City's Motion for Summary Judgment had still not
