26 **JOINT STATUS REPORT**

27 Complainant, LAS VEGAS POLICE PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATION, by and through its  
28 attorney of record, David Roger, Esq; Respondent, the City of Las Vegas (hereinafter “City” or  
“CLV”), by and through its attorney of record, Nechole Garcia, Esq. hereby submit their Joint  
Status Report pursuant to the Commissioner’s email dated July 19, 2023 in the above referenced  
matter.

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1 This case was stayed by the Board on November 5, 2021. The Association has filed two  
2 complaints for declaratory relief in District Court.

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4 In case no. A-21-835584-C, the Court is asked to decide whether the collective bargaining  
5 agreement requires the City to pay longevity benefits to officers.

6 A related case has been filed in case no. A-21-845029-C, which asks the court to  
7 determine whether the collective bargaining agreement allows the City to refuse to arbitrate  
8 longevity benefit claims when the City believes the grievances are untimely. The case was  
9 consolidated with A-21-835584-C.

10  
11 The parties completed discovery and obtained a new trial date. The City filed a motion  
12 for summary judgment which was set for hearing on July 31, 2024. The trial date was set for  
13 November 12, 2024.

14 Additionally, the original arbitration hearing, which included the first grievants, was  
15 vacated pending negotiations. The parties have been unable to resolve the matter and a new date  
16 has not been set.

17  
18 Since the last report, the pending hearing on the City's Motion for Summary Judgment,  
19 which was scheduled for July 31, 2024, occurred. Prior to hearing the motion, Judge Newberry  
20 recused herself from the case. Judge Honorable Ronald J. Israel was assigned the case on August  
21 16, 2024.

22  
23 On August 21, 2024, Judge Israel issued an Order indicating that he would be issuing a  
24 decision on the City's Motion for Summary Judgment without a hearing. Judge Israel has yet to  
25 issue a decision on the City's Motion for Summary Judgment.

26  
27 On October 15, 2024, the parties submitted a Stipulation and Order to Continue Trial to  
28 the Court, based, in part, on the fact that the City's Motion for Summary Judgment had still not

1 been adjudicated. On October 16, 2024, the Court filed an Order continuing Trial to February 10,  
2 2025. A Pre-Trial Conference / Calendar Call is scheduled for January 28, 2025.
